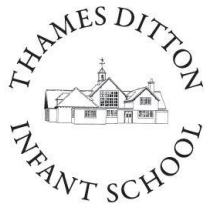


# The Ember Learning Trust

- As a result five local schools (Hinchley Wood Primary School, Long Ditton Infant and Nursery School, Long Ditton St Mary's Junior School, Thames Ditton Infant School, Thames Ditton Junior School) are now part of The Ember Learning Trust which was incorporated and registered at Companies House on July 29<sup>th</sup> 2016

- The Board explored ideas for greater cooperation on a range of educational and social areas and we will shortly be announcing how we will progress these

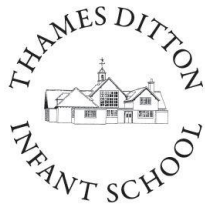
